I would like to reassure you that the class will have a teacher for September, either a permanent staff member or a supply teacher. As the Assistant Headteacher for this year group, I will work closely with any covering staff to ensure the needs of all children are met.

We are delighted to welcome a new member to our team, Miss Synders, and are excited to share that she is able to join us before the new academic year during part of MUSU. I am sure you will take your time to welcome her to our school.

At William Harding School our MUSU programme will begin on **Monday 10th July** and continue until the end of this academic year. From this date pick up and drop off will be as follows;
