Re: **Year 3 Mead Open Farm Trip**

I am pleased to inform you that year 3 have the wonderful opportunity to visit Mead Open Farm. We know this is short notice but these dates have just become available to us.

On the day, we intend to leave school at 9:15am and return to school by 3:00pm ready for normal pick up time.

This trip will be an exciting experience for the children and will be beneficial for consolidating their learning in English and allow the children an opportunity to experience life on a farm that they have been reading about in their class novel Charlotte's Web.

We will be having lunch at the woods so you will need to ensure your child has a packed lunch for this trip. If your child has a school lunch, please ensure you pre-order based on the special menu or provide a packed lunch.

All children will need to bring a backpack, a warm waterproof coat and a water bottle with them on the day. Children will need to wear the top half of their school uniform for identification purposes but as we expect the woods to be muddy, they can wear jogging bottoms or similar and waterproof shoes or wellies.

The cost of the day will be a voluntary contribution of £17 and will include the coach to and from Mead Open Farm, entry to the farm and all activities. Please could you register your consent and payment via The Gateway App. This needs to be completed by Friday 10th November, 2023. Please, note that if we do not receive enough uptake or contributions for the trip, then we may need to cancel.
