Our Multi-Activity Camp Includes extreme activities (such outdoor survival tasks, archery & inflatables) and offer risk taking, character development and a better understanding of how to keep safe. They also include physical activity sessions (such as dodgeball and capture the flag) and allow students to gain a better understanding of keeping physically healthy. Finally, the programme includes arts and crafts activities (such as resistant materials projects, clay modelling, painting and drawing) delivered by teachers and coaches who naturally embed a 'therapeutic' approach to improving emotional wellbeing.
