


Solvent	The liquid that something dissolves in
Solute	The material that dissolves in the solvent
Saturated	When no more of a solute can dissolve in a
	solvent
Reversible change	A change that can be reversed so the
	material goes back to how it was
Evaporation	When a liquid changes state to a gas
Filtering	Removing solids from a mixture by passing
	through paper that only allows liquid
	through
