
## COVID Catch-up premium plan 2022 - William Harding School





## Teaching

- ► Focussed Learning Days for engagement & broad and balanced curriculum for all
- ► LORIC/Debates for self esteem & sense of self
- ► Ensuring pupils are ready to learn with increased FLO support
- Additional TAs, Cover supervisors and 1 x teacher for support/teaching/boostering
- ► AHT teaching of boosters to support outcomes

## Wider strategies

- 2 additional FLOs, team of 5, in response to need (anxiety/bereavement etc)
- ► Increased School Counsellor hours
- ▶ IPSL (Inclusion, Pastoral, safeguarding lead) to lead on an increased Personal development curriculum/offer
- Increased engagement with agencies
- Re-engagement programme to support return to school
- ► Pastoral Mentor Programme
- ► Family room for families in crisis
- Nurture room for pupils in need of a quiet space and additional support
