The Magna Carta	A written agreement (charter) that was signed by King John
Civil war	A war between people who live in the same country
Coronation	When a king or queen is given the crown











King John signed the Magna Carta in 1216 Simon de Montfort captured Henry III and set up a parliament

Charles I was executed in 1649 Oliver Cromwell was the Lord Protector Charles II returned from hiding in France to be the king in 1660
