Maths

Over this half term, we will be cover lots of different concepts: place value and ordering and comparing numbers, formal written methods of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, the order of operations and begin to look at equivalent fractions. Additionally, we will have a short daily session focused on arithmetic as this proved to be a massive success last year.

English

Our focus for this half term will be on descriptive writing and non-narrative writing; including informal and formal language and standard English. We will be focusing on improving our use of punctuation and on using a variety of different sentence structures within our writing. We will be continuing to work on reading comprehension and on how we can use evidence from the text to make a variety of inferences. Our spelling focus for this half term is the years 5 and 6 list.

Reading

In SQUIRT (Super Quality Uninterrupted Independent Reading Time), we will be reading *The Clockwork Sparrow* by Katherine Woodfine.

Science

Our focus for this half term is 'The Heart'. We will be learning about the different functions and structures of the heart and this will include dissecting an animal's heart.

Primary Knowledge Curriculum

Our Geography topic is 'Spatial Sense' and we will be understanding how cartographers map the globe, the changes that have been made to maps and how they are recorded, how to use and read maps of the globe and understanding how the shape of the Earth and its rotation lead to day and night time as well as seasons in different countries.

Computing

Our Computing topic is 'coding' and we will be looking at some different projects to introduce and develop the children's understanding of programming, understanding how to use Scratch as a coding program and developing our skills in coding and how to use coding successfully.
