Reflect	When light bounces back from a surface
Shadow	A dark area created by an object blocking a light source



Our shadows change in shape and size as the position of the sun changes throughout the day.

Concave	When a mirror is bent inwards, creating a hollow – the image looks bigger
Convex	When a mirror is bent outwards, creating an arch—the image looks smaller
