


Mirror	A surface which reflects a clear image.
Shadow	A dark patch where light has been blocked
Reflection	The return of light from a surface.
Prism	A wedge-shaped object which can split white light into a
	rainbow spectrum of colours.





A Periscope – a device that uses reflection of light to allow the user to see something that is out of their line of sight.

At A, the mirrors are tilted 45° and at B the light reflects from the mirrors travelling down the Periscope. At C, the image can be seen by the user.
