The chosen measure for this is the entitlement of Free School Meals within the past 6 years. The current funding is £1,300 per pupil

Aim/Outcome:


- To raise aspirations

Additional funding

<u>Overview:</u> To provide a uniform, breakfast or other essentials for disadvantaged pupils who are in need.

- Increased confidence and self-esteem in all children
- Pupils arrive on time to school and prepared to learn
- Pupils are happier at home and school, therefore able to access learning

Attendance and punctuality

<u>Overview:</u> To support pupils and families through the FLO support team and breakfast club for those persistently late

Aim/Outcome:

- Pupils attend school regularly to receive a good education and build strong relationships with peers and adults
- Pupils attend school and are kept safe
- Pupils arrive on time and late anxiety is removed
