## **Re: Verulamium Museum**

I am pleased to inform you that year 3 have managed to organise a school trip to visit the Verulamium Museum on Monday 29<sup>th</sup> April and Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

The following classes will be going on the allocated days:

Beech and Hawthorn: Monday 29th April.

## Willow and Rowan: Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April.

On both days, we intend to leave the school at 11:30am and return to school by 3:10pm ready for normal pick up time.

This trip will be an exciting experience for the children and will be beneficial for consolidating their learning in History. We will be exploring a variety of different artefacts, dressing up as Romans and learning about how Romans lived. On both days, we will be having an early lunch at around 11am, if all children could bring in a packed lunch and a water bottle. They can bring a small water bottle and a small snack with them in a bag, which they can carry through the duration of the trip. They will need to bring a warm, waterproof coat. Children will be required to wear their normal school uniform to identify them as part of our school group.

The cost of the day will be a voluntary contribution of **£14** and will include the coach to and from the Verulamium Museum, the self-guided tour of the Museum and the interactive workshop.
