# RE: School Disco - 14th June 2024

We are writing to let you know that we will be holding a school disco during the day on Friday 14th June

In response to feedback from our community and recognising the challenges some families face with attending evening events, we have decided to hold daytime discos. This change aims to make participation more accessible to all our students and families.

Here is the revised schedule for the discos:

• Reception: 9:00 AM - 9:30 AM

• **Year 1 and 2:** 9:35 AM – 10:20 AM

Year 3 and 4: 10:30 AM – 11:30 AM

• Year 5 and 6: 2:00 PM - 3:15 PM

Tickets for the discos are priced at £2 each and can be purchased through School Gateway. Please contact the school office if you experience any difficulty.

Attendance at the discos is entirely optional. For those children who choose not to attend, or parents/carers have not purchased a ticket, alternative activities will be provided in their classrooms during the disco times.

Please note the following clothing guidelines for the different year groups:

## Reception

• Arrive at school in disco clothes and change back into their school uniforms afterwards.

### Years 1-4

• Come to school dressed in their uniforms. They will have the opportunity to change into disco attire and will change back into their uniforms before the end of the day.

### Year 5 and 6

• Attend school in uniform but are welcome to change into disco clothes for the event. They will not need to change back into their uniforms afterwards.

During the discos, children will have access to refreshments included in the ticket price. No additional money will be required from the students.

We believe these adjustments will enhance the disco experience for our students and families, and we appreciate your understanding and support with this format.
