Dear parents and carers,

Re: Clubs Survey Response

Thank you to all of the families that responded to the club survey. We are keen to work with our families and hear your views.

It was great to see that the majority of parents who responded felt that we have a wide range of clubs on offer to our pupils. Our amazing staff give up their free time to volunteer to run clubs because they want to provide a wide range of additional opportunities for the children. These are offered for free so that all pupils have access.

There were some requests for additional places at clubs. We have to ensure that we have sufficient staff to pupil ratios to run a club, which is why there is a limit to the number of places. In order to extend the places, we would need additional staff. Staff members have their own commitments and we cannot request that any staff member runs a club. We could, however, offer to pay staff to help run clubs and therefore offer additional places. This cost would have to be passed on to parents and we would have to start charging for the clubs at that point.

We have looked at the club requests made on the survey. A number of the requested clubs have been run this year already or currently run at lunchtimes or after school. We monitor the uptake of clubs and ensure that we continue to run popular ones. We know that places are limited in the after-school clubs and that pupils also have other commitments after school. We therefore run lunchtime clubs as well.
