Dear parents and carers,

Re: Come and Read

On Monday 12th December we would like to invite parents in to school for our Come and Read session. Come and Read is an opportunity for you to come in to school to share a book and read with your children. You will enter the school via the front door. Staff will be on hand to show you where you need to go.

The children will already be in their classroom. You would then sit with your child and share a book with them in the classroom. Staff will share books with children who do not have a parent with them.

If you have children in separate classes you can choose either to see each one individually or read with both at the same time. If you wish to read with both at the same time, please collect one child from their classroom and take them to the other classroom to share a book with them both. The teacher must sign out the child who is leaving the classroom before you take them with you.

When Come and Read finishes you can take your child / children home with you straight away rather than having to wait at the gate as normal. The teacher must sign your child / children out before you take them with you. You will leave via the front entrance.

In addition to attending the come and read, we would like to invite Reception and KS1 parents to a 10 minute presentation in which you can learn a bit about our phonics scheme and how you can support your child with their reading and phonics at home. The session will be held in the KS1 hall from 2:20-2:30 before Come and Read begins.

Timings

In order to reduce congestion at the entrance we have split the entrance times

Reception and KS1 session is 2:20pm-3:00pm.

KS2 session is 2:45pm – 3:15pm

Pre-school is 2:30pm-3:00pm and entrance is via the pre-school entrance.
