The courses are delivered via Impact Futures' online learning platform with support from fully qualified, experienced tutors. Everything is completed online, including the assessments. You can access the online training at a time that suits you, and there are no set dates or times for the sessions. You can complete as many courses as you want, and you will receive a nationally recognised certificate from the Awarding Body upon completion of the course(s).

To be eligible you must:

- Be aged 19 and above
- Have been a resident in the UK for at least three years, and be able to provide proof of ID/residency
