Meet our Family Liaison Officers.














The Family Support Service offers a number of opportunities to access help with groups such as:

- Parenting Support
- Early Years Developmental Issues
- Youth Work Programmes
- Support for those Affected by Domestic Violence
- · Family Learning

The Family Support Service can work with families, children or young people who need help because they are:

- Excluded from school or having difficulties engaging with education
- Currently or at risk of becoming NEET (Not in Education, Employment or Training)
- Affected by domestic abuse or parental conflict
- · Demonstrating risk-taking behaviour
- Impacted by the consequences of substance misuse
- Affected by poor mental health
- Impacted by poor attachments or relationships within the family
- Having difficulty parenting in a consistent way
- Impacted by financial problems and debt
- Having difficulty maintaining boundaries and expectations within the home
- Involved with the criminal justice system
- Young carers
- Vulnerable to exploitation.
- In a home environment impacting on the health and well-being of a child


