Cycle path and footpaths

We have been made aware that there have had some concerns raised about the blocking of the cycle path and the footpaths outside the front of the school before and after school. Parents with buggies and bikes are struggling to get through, as are other local residents. In order to reduce this, we ask that parents only arrive from drop off and pick up just before the allocated time. We ask that we show consideration to others using the roads and paths around our school.

We ask that parents do not congregate on the pavements or cycle path to talk to friends for lengthy periods of time, either before or after drop off or collection. Groups of parents / families congregating on the pavement have been causing an obstruction to families using the pavement. We are concerned that this is likely to result in an accident as there have been near misses in the past. We thank you for your support and co-operation in this matter.
