Dear Year 1 Parents,

Re: Year 1 Artist in Residence – Assemblage Art Workshop, Thursday 19th May

On Thursday 19th May, the William Harding artist in residence will be running a workshop in Year 1, giving children the opportunity to create their own assemblage art pieces.

‘Assemblage’ art is a type of sculpture where objects are gathered together - typically everyday objects or found objects, objects found in everyday life or objects that are discarded. We are going to make assemblage art based on recycling these objects.

To create our assemblage art pieces, we would like children to bring in objects that the children will love looking at and talking about in their artwork, with no items bigger than an adult’s hand. Examples of objects that could be brought in to create assemblage art includes:

- Foreign coins
- Toy metal/plastic cars
- Nuts and bolts
- Sunglasses
- Paint brushes
- Non precious jewelry
- Springs
- Dolls
- Figurines
- Lego figures
- Plastic fruit/veg
- Old watches
