Dear parents and carers,

Re: Warwick Castle

We are pleased to inform you that the Year 1 will have the opportunity to go on a school trip to Warwick Castle.

We will be visiting on **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> June**.

All children will need to be in full school uniform and ensure they bring a water bottle, comfortable shoes, a light rain coat and a sun hat on the day. Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them on the trip. We ask that all children bring a plastic bag with their lunch in it, please also ensure the items children bring can be put in a bin after lunch. Please be aware unfortunately Freshstart don't provide a deli option for a trip on a Monday.

To ensure we make the most of our visit, there will be slightly different timings to the school day for children attending the trip. Children will need to arrive at school at 8:00am on the KS1 playground, ready to leave at 8.30am. We will arrive back at approximately 4-4:15pm and we will endeavor to have children on the KS1 playground to be picked up by 4:15-4:30pm.

Please be aware, if your child comes into school via a taxi we will be leaving on time so if they haven't come into school by 8:00am they will stay in school with other members of staff. At pick up the taxis won't be available so you would need to make alternative arrangements to pick up your child.

Please know that we will do everything we can to arrive back to the school on time, however, if there are any changes to the time for pick up, a SchoolComms will be sent out to inform you.

This trip will be an exciting experience for the children and will explore our art topic of architecture, our geography topic of human landmarks in the UK and our History topic of Kings & Queens. The children will have the chance to explore a historical royal party and watch live shows in the castle grounds.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £31. Please register your consent and payment via The Gateway App. This needs to be completed by Monday 20th May. Note that we do not receive enough uptake for the trip, then we may need to cancel.
