Re: Year 2 Trip to Bournemouth Beach

We are pleased to announce that Year 2 have organised a trip to **Bournemouth Beach**.

Each class will be going on the following days:

Juniper and Lime: Friday 7th June 2024

Cherry and Elder: Thursday 13th June 2024

To ensure we make the most of our visit, on this day there will be slightly different timings to the school day. Children will need to arrive at school no later than **7:00am**, ready to leave at **7.30am**. We will arrive back at approximately **5pm for a 5:15pm pick up**. Please note that if children are not attending the trip, they are still expected at school and will be placed within another class for the day.

This trip will be an exciting experience for the children and will be beneficial for our Geography topic about the British Isles and coastlines. The children will spend time flying kites, building sandcastles, visiting the Pier and 'chasing the tide'.

On the day, the children can wear casual, appropriate clothing for the beach, but we ask that they wear an item of clothing (polo/jumper) that identifies them as William Harding pupils. **Due to us leaving early on the day, children will be required to bring a packed lunch, snack and water bottle from home as fresh start will be unable to provide a school lunch.** We also ask that all children bring sun cream and a hat to wear.

The cost of the trip will be a voluntary contribution of £21. Please could you register your consent and payment via The Gateway App by **Friday 31st May 2024**. If you feel you have financial circumstances which will cause difficulty in contributing, please contact our school office in confidence.
