Year 4 pupils came back from an amazing trip to Woodrow last week. They have been talking about their experiences ever since.

The children not only took part in fantastic activities but they also had the joy of some snow as well. The children participated in many physical activities such as Archery, Low Ropes, a Challenge Course, Pioneering (building a large catapult from wooden poles and ropes) and Jacob’s Ladder (High Ropes). The instructors taught the children many survival skills including what to eat if stranded and how to start a small fire in the woods to keep warm.
