As you may know, we are currently reading C. S. Lewis' The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe in our SQUIRT sessions. The children are really loving the story and are excited at the prospect of being able to watch the film adaptation.

I am excited to announce that we have arranged an extra special viewing of The Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe at Aylesbury's ODEON Luxe Cinema. This exclusive showing is just for our Year 5 pupils and will not be available to the public. The private screening will take place during normal school hours on **Wednesday 29th March 2023**.

The version we will be watching is the 2005 and is rated a PG (parental guidance). This is due to battle scenes and mild fantasy violence in addition to short scenes of mild threat some children may find frightening. By registering your consent for the trip, you will also be registering your consent for your child to watch this PG rated film.

The total cost of this trip will be **£11** and this includes the ticket to this special screening as well as a kids mix per child containing a child-sized popcorn, two bagged sweets and a drink. Please inform your child's class teacher of any food allergies or needs as we will ensure that no child is denied refreshments.

We will be walking to and from the cinema and the children will return to school in time for a late lunch. It would be advisable for children to have a packed lunch on this day, however school lunches may still be pre-ordered based on the trip lunch menu.

Please note that if we do not receive enough uptake or contributions for the trip, then we may need to cancel as the school budget cannot afford to subsidise trips or visits as it would impact on other areas within school.
