Dear parents/carers of Year 6

Re: Imperial War Museum London Trip

We are pleased to inform you that we have arranged for the children to visit **The Imperial War Museum** in London as part of our topic in history, **World War 1.** The children will have the opportunity to explore the museum as part of a small group led by a member of school staff and explore the museum's gallery based around World War 1. There will also be an opportunity for us to explore other galleries within the museum that are based around World War 2 to further their knowledge on the whole topic of World Wars.

Dudley and Warwick will be going on Thursday 23rd November 2023.

Windsor and Cardiff will be going on Monday 27th November 2023.

The pupils will need to wear their school uniform, including appropriate school shoes for walking around. There is a short walk from the coach to the museum and so pupils will require a coat if the weather is cold or wet. The coach will need to leave school at 8:25am and therefore the <u>children will need to be in school for 8:00am</u>. If we can leave earlier, this will to allow us to have as much time as possible in the museum. The <u>coach will arrive back at school at 4:00pm</u>.

Lunch: The children will need to bring a packed lunch. Everything must be disposable – no lunchboxes please. Please do not pack sweets, bottles or fizzy drinks.

<u>Cost:</u> The cost of the trip will be a voluntary contribution of **£17.00** per child. This includes all the activities at the centre and the cost of the coaches. <u>Please make payment and consent via School Comms by Friday</u> <u>17th November 2023.</u>

The trip will go ahead if the contributions are received per pupil but will be cancelled if there is any shortfall. The school budget cannot afford to subsidise the trips as it would impact on other areas within school.
