Re: Year 6 leavers activities

Firstly, I would like to thank you for your engagement with the survey that was sent out last week. As per my previous letter, I explained that we would be carrying out a number of activities for the Year 6 leavers to celebrate their time at William Harding School and the hard work they put in for their SATs. We would like to confirm that the details are below for the different activities, along with some information regarding each one.

Rogue Bowling:

We will be attending Rogue Bowling on **Thursday 7th July**, where the children will have the opportunity to play two games of bowling. We will require permission from a parent or guardian for your child to attend Rogue Bowling, this can be done via the school gateway. We would like to ask for a voluntary contribution of **£12 per child** which can be made via the school gateway. This voluntary contribution will pay for the children to have two games of bowling and the coach journey.

Year 6 leavers disco:

We have set the date for our school disco, which will be **Friday 15th July from 5:30pm till 7:30pm**. We have organised for there to be: a photobooth, candy floss machine, popcorn machine and other surprises. As well as this, we will also be arranging for a dominos delivery as the food for the evening. We will require permission from a parent or guardian for your child to attend the Year 6 leavers disco, this can be done via the school gateway.
